### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: FISH



#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

God had a special mission for Jonah, but Jonah ran away from God. God sent a storm and then a big fish to get Jonah's attention. In the end, Jonah realized the importance of obeying God. Jonah 1 & 2, Jonah and The Big Fish



#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Review some of your household rules with your kids. What rules always get followed? What rules usually get ignored? Ask everyone for ideas on how they can improve on obeying all the rules - house rules, and God's rules.



#### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why did Jonah run away from God?
- Why did God give Jonah a second chance?
- Why is it important to be obedient to God?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

*"Lord, show me your ways. Teach me how to follow you." Psalm 25:4 (NirV)*



#### PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

God wants us to obey Him the first time. The more we obey God, the more He can use us to point others to Jesus. Ask God to help you model that obedience for your children.
