THIS WEEK'S LESSON: FROG



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

God loved His people and promised to free them from slavery in Egypt. God showed his power to the evil Pharaoh through 10 plagues – one of which was the plague of frogs. Though Pharaoh's heart was hard, God's power was greater. Exodus 8:1-15, The Plague of Frogs



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Do a battery check this week on smoke alarms and/or flashlights with the kids. As you test these devices to see if they need power, ask your kids how they know that God is all-powerful.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why did God send ten plagues to Egypt?
- Is there anyone more powerful than God?
- How can we experience God's power?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Lord, show me your ways. Teach me how to follow you." Psalm 25:4 (NirV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

God uses His power to help His people. That was true in Egypt, and it is true for His church today. Pray with your kids this week, and ask God to use His power in your church to change your city for Jesus.
