### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: SNAKE



#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

In the Garden of Eden, the snake tempted Adam and Eve to eat the forbidden fruit. But it was ultimately their decision to disobey God and choose to sin. In the world, there is temptation all around us, but it is our choice whether or not we say yes to temptation or yes to God's way. Genesis 3:1-15, 21-24, The Fall



#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Do your kids own up to responsibility when they make a mistake? Do you? Challenge your family members to own up to their mistakes and decisions this week. Don't blame others. Accept responsibility and take action.



#### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why was eating the forbidden fruit Adam and Eve's fault and not the snake's fault?
- Do we always have a choice to do the right thing when we are tempted to sin?
- What can we do to help us remember to make the wise choice and not sin?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

*"Lord, show me your ways. Teach me how to follow you." Psalm 25:4 (NIRV)*



#### PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

As people with free will, we always have the choice to not sin when we are tempted. It may not feel like it in the moment, but the choice is always there. Pray that your kids will have not only the wisdom but the courage to say no to temptation and do the right thing when they are challenged.
