THIS WEEK'S LESSON: RAVEN



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

After Elijah delivered a message from God to the evil king, he fled to safety. Out in the wilderness, God sent ravens to look after Elijah's needs. 1 Kings 17:1-6, Elijah Fed By Ravens



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Help your kids to set up quiet spaces in their rooms to read the Bible and pray. Put something in that space to remind them that God is always with them!



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why was Elijah lonely?
- How did God show Elijah that He was still with him?
- How do we know God is with us in lonely times?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Lord, show me your ways. Teach me how to follow you." Psalm 25:4 (NirV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

It's important to realize that God is always with us. In good times and bad, and especially in the lonely places of our lives, God is only a prayer away. Pray with your kids for God's presence to be felt in your house, and remind them that God is always by their side.
